

COMMUNITY OUTREACH

LCCC seeks to create a vibrant community for all, where people connect and prosper and communities grow through rich cultural experiences. The following section highlights opportunities for students and community members alike to access all that LCCC has to offer.

Commitment to the Arts

Through the Arts and Humanities division, students and community members may participate in LCCC's theater, orchestra, concert band, jazz band, or choral groups. These civic ensembles bring together individuals with diverse levels of experience to create meaningful artistic performances. Music ensembles include the Civic Chorale, Civic Orchestra, Concert Band, and Jazz Band, all of which are open to participants with no fees or auditions required. Theater productions require auditions for acting roles, and a variety of technical positions are also available.

Stocker Humanities and Fine Arts Center

Stocker Arts Center (<https://www.lorainccc.edu/stocker/about-the-stocker-arts-center/>) features the 984-seat maximum (variable from 934 seats) Hoke Theatre; the 217-seat Lecture Hall; the 217-seat Cinema Hall; the flexible black box, Cirigliano Studio Theatre; a Dance Studio; a Rehearsal Hall; and the Beth K. Stocker Art Gallery. The Center presents performances by professional dance, theater and music attractions, a fine arts film series and art gallery exhibitions. The Stocker Arts Center is also the home of the Arts and Humanities division, which includes the Civic Orchestra, Civic Chorale, Civic Concert Band, Civic Jazz Band and theater. These organizations perform numerous events at the center annually.

Spitzer Conference Center

The John A. Spitzer Conference Center (<https://www.lorainccc.edu/spitzer/>), dedicated in honor of John A. Spitzer, 1917-1992, is the community's gathering place for conferences, trade shows, seminars or workshops. Guests have access to advanced technologies and comfortable, executive-level appointments catered by award-winning chefs. All events include complimentary event planning assistance and free parking. Spitzer Conference Center's team of dedicated, experienced professionals is committed to providing the ultimate guest experience.

The Campana Center for Ideation and Invention

The Patsie C. and Dolores Jeneé Campana Center for Ideation and Invention (<https://www.lorainccc.edu/campana/>) features state-of-the-art digital manufacturing labs equipped with high-tech equipment for fabrication, automation, 3D printing and more. It's surrounded by collaboration space and services to facilitate the full spectrum of product development – from initial ideation to prototyping through assembly and packaging. The Center offers hands-on education for students through college courses and K-12 programs while giving community inventors, entrepreneurs and existing companies access to cutting-edge digital manufacturing capabilities.

The Culinary Arts Institute

The Culinary Arts Institute of Lorain County Community College (<https://www.lorainccc.edu/culinary-institute/>) is a collaboration between visionary chefs, a talented student pool, and farm-to-table initiatives. As Northeast Ohio's destination for culinary arts, the Culinary Arts Institute

provides a place where business and industry leaders find the best professional development offerings, entrepreneurs create opportunities to expand businesses and skills, and members of our community come together to learn, cook and eat.

Recreation Opportunities

All of the Ewing Activities Center recreation facilities (<https://www.lorainccc.edu/fitness-and-recreation/>) are available to the public through enrollment in NPER 189. Youth under the age of 18 must have a guardian complete a waiver form. Youth under the age of 13 must be accompanied and actively supervised by a parent or a guardian. Youth 9 years old and younger are not permitted in any HPER facilities or hallway unless enrolled in a class for youth activities.

The Ewing Activities Center provides facility rental to corporate and general public groups. The ropes course experience, which includes team-building activities, low and high ropes course elements, is also available to public and corporate groups.

LCCC has also partnered with SilverSneakers (r), Renew Active and Prime to offer insurance-based fitness plans. All program participants have access to the fitness center, field house, gym (during open hours) and track – all free of charge.

Commodore Kids

LCCC's Commodore Kids (<https://www.lorainccc.edu/community/commodore-kids/>) program offers a full spectrum of expert care and learning opportunities for children and teens. In addition to comprehensive childcare, preschool and after-school care, Commodore Kids offers a variety of courses and camps for academic development, personal enrichment or just for fun.
